Tour the Cold Springs Water Company Facilities Friday, July 5, 2013 – 10 am

Cold Springs Water Company invites all Cold Springs and Peter Pam cabin owners to tour the water facilities. The tour will begin at the Cold Water Company office. It will last about 3 hours depending on the number of people participating. Those driving their own vehicles are free to leave the tour at any time.

The tour will be on paved roads with the exception of the visit to the main pumping station at the Boy Scout Camp High Sierra. That drive is on the unpaved but very 'driveable' Jenness Park road off of Highway 108 just west of Lassen Drive. If you haven't been down there it is definitely worth the minimal effort. A four-wheel drive vehicle is not required to make the drive to the main pumping station at Camp High Sierra.

The tour will visit the water treatment plant off of Lassen Drive and the main storage tanks at the highest point in Cold Springs with very nice views. A visit to the main pumping station on the north fork Tuolumne River is recommended as is the walk to the diversion dam.

There is some walking involved. The walk to the diversion dam is very pleasant. It involves crossing the North Fork Tuolumne River on a log and then walking about half-mile on a gentle and shaded upslope. All other walking is shorter distances.
